The **North Dakota Governor's Awards for the Arts** program is presented by the Governor's Office and the North Dakota Council on the Arts (NDCA) to recognize organizations and individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the arts in the state. Nominations for the 2023 North Dakota Governor's Awards for the Arts are now being accepted. *You may download, print and mail a nomination but *online submissions preferred*.

Awards are presented in five categories:

- Individual Achievement (artist, staff, or volunteer)
- Nonprofit Arts Organization
- For-profit Arts Organization or Private Business
- Arts in Education (teaching artist, educator, school, or administrator)
- Individual Cultural Heritage Award

Criteria for the awards include:

- Expanding arts opportunities to new audiences
- Improving the quality of arts experiences
- Length of service in the arts
- Creating an appreciation for North Dakota's cultural heritage
- Making the arts more central to education and an integral part of community life

Artist in Residence is a noncompetitive reimbursement grant program that provides up to \$2,500 in support for North Dakota pre-K-12 students and teachers to work with professional artists either in a traditional school setting or during after-school and/or summer programs.
