Greta has used muralism to explore the ways that art can bring communities together, the power of visual language to activate voice, and the potential of art as a vehicle for hands-on organizing and educating.

In the first of this 2-part web series, meet Greta; she will describe her artistic journey and mural practice, introducing the poly tab technique. Participants will hear about her education, mural formations and the driving questions that continue to shape her artistic journey. There will be an open Q&A session.



Part 2 will take place at the end of July. This indirect mural technique will be implemented for the first time in North Dakota in a large-scale community project on the Grant Marshal Bridge and will include public community painting events.
